

When preparing for this year's Discrete Maths exam, you might want to pay special attention to the following problems.

Prob. Set 1: 3, 4, 6, 7, 8

Prob. Set 2: 1, 2, 3, 5

Prob. Set 3: 1, 2, 5

Prob. Set 4: 1, 2, 5

Prob. Set 5: 1, 2, 5, 6

Prob. Set 6: 3, 4, 5

Prob. Set 7: 2, 5, 6

Of course . . .

- These suggestions imply neither that the exam will definitely involve *all* the topics covered in these problems, nor that these problems are the *only* things you should study.
- You'd be wise to review your lecture notes as well. At the very least, make sure that you know how to define all the terms used in the problems above.
